Our classes run from 9:30am till 1pm every Friday. We like to focus on having fun but also help people to make the most of the foods that they have by wasting less and saving money.

Our classes are held in the 5* kitchens at the CEP building in Coalville: Unit 1-2, Market Street, Coalville, LE67 3DX (near the clock tower).

After cooking we eat together or take our food home to share with our families.

Free childcare is provided for the children of volunteers (aged 6+) in our homework club.

We are looking for people aged 18+ to participate in the classes.

Volunteers will:

- Receive full training – this starts on Friday 15th March 9:30am till 1pm.
- Have opportunity to get a food hygiene qualification.
- Have opportunity to gain experience in the following areas: hospitality and catering, event planning and project management.
- Have access to free childcare while volunteering (for parents or carers with children aged 6+).
- Many volunteers manage to reduce their food bills by about 10% as a result of taking part.
- Meet new people and make new friends and help people to reduce waste and save money.
