All volunteers are registered, with DBS checks & will carry a Good Neighbour Scheme ID with their photo.

- ♥ **Transport for a variety of purposes like G.P. & hospital appointments, shopping etc.**
- ♥ **Practical help such as shopping, collecting library books, prescriptions, pensions etc.**
- ♥ **Simple help around the house and garden.**
- ♥ **Form filling, documents & computer issues**
- ♥ **A friendly face to talk to.**

The scheme is free though clients would be expected to pick up any car parking charges. There are no rigid rules, but there is an understanding that the scheme is there to help those generally in some sort of need.
